Missionary Minute - Don & Teleka Dewing: Midwest Indian Mission
 Don and Teleka are so thankful for our support during this very harsh winter. Their food pantry is doing very well as they continue to serve an average of 165 families per month. The New Hope Shelter is in need of support as they housed 9 residents for a total of 160 sheltered nights in January. Also, in January the Mission sponsored Parry Stelter and family, of Word of Hope Ministries, they spoke for 9 days, giving messages on grief, loss and trauma, to all 3 of the reservation churches and people were very encouraged. Dewings will travel to Parkersburg Iowa for a mission Conference March 8th - 11th at the First Congregational Church.
